MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING SLEEPY HOLLOW BOARD OF TRUSTEES AUGUST 4, 1975

A regular meeting of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Sleepy Hollow was called to order by the President, Mrs. Schoengart, at 7:45 P. M. on Monday, August 4, 1975 in the Village hall. The Pledge of Allegiance was said by all present and a moment of silence observed in memory of the late Chief of Police, Lawrence J. Sabatino.

Roll call was taken and answered as follows:

Mrs. Schoengart - present

Mr. Kæueger moved that the minutes of the July 21, 1975 meeting be accepted as presented to the board by the clerk. Mr. Dykhouse seconded. Motion carried by voice vote.

The treasurer's report was given by Mr. Dykhouse in the absence of the treasurer, Mr. Nolte. Cash receipts were in the amount of \$7,700.18 to the General Funds, \$1,500 to the Building fund, \$\$3,565.89 to the Motor Fuel Tax Fund and \$1,959 to the Revenue Sharing Fund. Balances are as follows: \$4,719.14 in the General Funds; \$4,084.25 in the Building Fund; \$32,650.24 in the MFT Funds; \$3,764.96 in the Revenue Sharing Funds; \$736,926.57 in the Road Bond Funds. Bills payable were presented in the amount of \$930.19 from the General Funds, \$640.32 from the Revenue Sharing Funds and \$394.85 from the Road Bond Funds.

Mr. Dykhouse moved that the bills be paid as presented. Mr. Krueger seconded. Roll call: Ciuca, Dykhouse, Krueger, Schoengart, aye; O nays; 3 absent; motion carried.

Mrs. Schoengart thanked all for showing their respects for Chief Sabatino.

The Board will consider a special census at this time. Mr. Dykhouse will check into the particulars.

Mr. Dykhouse will be Mayor Pro-tem during the absence of Mrs. Schoengart in August.

A Plan Commission meeting will be held August 11, 1975 in the Village Hall at $8\ P.\ M.$

Mrs. Schoengart read a letter from Mrs. Karen Ross praising the Village for good maintenance of the roads in this pre-road building time.

A petition was presented from the residents of Hilltop Court asking for a "dead end" sign. The Village will install one if possible and look into one for permanent installment when the roads are complete.

Mr. Dykhouse moved that any amount of State Income Tax in excess of \$1500.00 be placed in the General Fund instead of the Building Fund each time an income tax check is received. Mr. Krueger seconded. Roll call: Ciuca, Dykhouse, Male, Krueger, aye; O nays; motion carried.

Mrs. Male moved that the meeting be adjourned. Mr. Krueger seconded. Meeting adjourned at 8:45 P. M.
