Village Board Minutes November 5, 1984

The regular meeting of the Sleepy Hollow Corporate Authorities was called to order by President Peterson on November 5, 1984 at 7:30 PM in the Village Hall. Roll call: Cook, Matthews, Roberts, Treece, Peterson present; also Clerk Pofahl, Treasurer Panning, Chief Bradley, Attorney Knickerbocker.

Mr. Treece moved to accept the minutes of the previous meeting, second by Cook, carried by voice.

President: The IML has negotiated an agreement with the phone coregarding franchise fees, etc. A model ordinance has been given to the Attorney.

DuKane Valley Council, Nov. 15 LWV Carpentersville-Dundee, School Finance, Nov. 8

Attorney: The ordinance establishing the special service area for sewers was presented. The agreement with West Dundee must be renegotiated.

Thomas arrived 7:50.

The Chateau Louise water bills is not worth pursuing. Rabe arrived 7:55.

Four pieces of property have received tax exempt status. One with a wrong legal description (015) has been picked up by someone else, who has let the taxes go.

Ordinance #5-7-10, sewer service area, was discussed, Mr. Treece moved to pass Ordinance #5-7-10 establishing a special service area for sewer service, second by Mrs. Matthews, roll call: all present aye.

Soil borings will be done Wednesday by PSI Industries, Inc., A&H Flood Engineering Division.

Treasurer: Mr. Treece moved to pay bills presented on warrant; General, \$14,869.93; Rd. & Bridge, \$2776.55; Water O&M, \$5823.24, second by Thomas, roll call: all present aye. The audits have been presented to the Board.

Building permits in sewer area: six months before completion of sewer, building permits will be issued, but no occupancy permits until sewer hooked up to house.

Court date, Wednesday, Nov, 7, 10:00 AM, re: Hazzard.

Mrs. Matthews moved to authorize the engineer to have aerial photos of the sewer area taken for designing of project, second by Roberts, roll call: all present aye.

Mrs. Whatthews moved to authorize the Engineer to start design work as necessary, cost not to exceed that stipulated in cost estimate, second by Roberts, roll call: all present aye.

Mr. Rabe moved to increase Dale's hourly wage to \$5.50 and give him 7 paid holidays, second by Matthews: Mr. Thomas moved to amend to \$6.00 and no holidays, second by Rabe; defeated by voice vote. Mr. Thomas moved to amedn to \$5.75 per hour and no paid holidays, carried by voice, main motion carried, roll call: all present aye. Effective date Nov. 7, 1984.

The water bills to those residents on wells within 100 feet of a main have been sent. It is possible to have wells tested through a service from the State. Cook will pursue.

The Water Dept. billing Clerk would like a copy of building permit for new house which will eventually have water.

Mr. Cook moved to adjourn, second by Thomas, adjourn 9:25PM
