DIRECTOR OF FINANCE

1. Ziemba moved with a second from Seiler to approve the accounts payable of February 20, 2012 in the amount of \$34,542.60. Aye: Ziemba, Seiler, Finney, Nemec. Motion passed. The Board would like a report on the income/expenses of the towing program to date.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

PARKS, ROADS AND STREETS

FINANCE

- The Finance Committee has completed their review of the police proposal from West Dundee. Trustee Ziemba would like to get costs for paying into the state fund for unemployment which the Village has not been part of in the past. We would not be able to join the fund until January 1st, however.
- The West Dundee police proposal will be discussed at the March 19th meeting and the Finance Committee and Ad Hoc Committee members may attend.

WATER AND SEWER

- 1. Fire hydrants have been ordered. The money will come from capital improvements.
- The new sewer meters are reading higher than the old ones. Trustee Seiler would like to monitor them for a few weeks but if the higher readings continue, the sewer costs will increase substantially. The meters are calibrated correctly. There is concern that some residents may have connected other lines to drain into the sewer system, which is not permitted. Sewer district residents will be sent a letter advising them of upcoming village inspections to ensure there are no illegal hook ups to the sewer system.

POLICE AND PUBLIC SAFETY

Finney moved with a second from Nemec to approve Resolution No. 434 entitled "A Resolution Exercising an Option to Renew an Intergovernmental Agreement with the County of Kane for Animal Control Services." Motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC BUILDINGS AND ENVIRONMENTAL

- There have been 16 deer taken from the village for sampling. There have been three deer taken elsewhere in Dundee Township that have tested positive for chronic wasting disease.
- A speaker from Energy Choices attended the Environmental Committee meeting. They explained the program to give residents the choice to "opt-in" to their energy savings program. Energy Choices would pay for an informational mailing to residents, which is an alternative to ComEd. Energy would be purchased at a lower cost, guaranteed through May 2013. This program was established through the Council of Mayors to assist villages. Information could be included in the upcoming newsletter.
- The Environmental Committee recommends purchasing \$2,500 of trees to sell to residents this year. Trees not sold will be planted in the Village to meet our Tree City USA obligations.
