

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING

April 3, 1967

The following are the minutes of the regular monthly meeting of the Village of Sleepy Hollow, April 3, 1967. The meeting was called to order at 7:50 PM by Mayor Falese. Roll call was taken and answered as follows:

The minutes of the March 6 meeting were read by the clerk. Mr.

Knott made a motion that the minutes be accepted as read. Mr. Geis seconded. Roll call 5-0, 1 absent.

Mr. Quigley read the treasurer's report for the months of February and March. After a long discussion on the financial status of the Village, a committee was set up to check out the possibility of getting a Tax Anticipation Warrant with a bonding company. The committee will consist of Larry Knott, Ron Fischer, Ray Strass, Dave Quigley, and Larry Sabatino. Report to be ready by the next board meeting. Mr. Fischer read the Police Report for the month of March.

Mr. Geis read a letter from Rakow & Associates on bids received for salt and patching mix. Mr. Geis made a motion to accept W. R. Meadows bid on the patching mixture for \$9.00 per ton and Cargill, Inc.'s bid on salt for \$12.80 per ton. Mr. Hlavacek seconded the motion. Roll call 5-0, 1 absent.

Mr. Fischer read the building permit report. Two permits were issued for the sum of \$370.00.

Mr. Fischer read a letter regarding a survey that is to be conducted in the area for Channel 11 between the dates of April 8-16.

Mr. Strass noted that on a recent land survey it was discovered that a parcel of land wasn't properly annexed to the village.

Ordinance 67-4 was written to annex this parcel of land. Reading of the ordinance was waived. Mr. Fischer motioned to adopt Ord.

67-4 on the annexation of the land. Mr. Lindemann seconded.

Roll call 5-0, 1 absent.

Mr. Fischer stated that he was ready to go ahead with the village census, but was waiting for a check to cover expenses.

Mr. Strass gave a brief summary of the meeting held in his office

with Mr. Rogers and his committee on amending Ord. 67-3. Mr. Rogers also gave his opinion of the meeting and expressed his satisfaction with the amendment. Mr. Strass read Ord. 67-3. Both Mr. Rogers and Mr. O'Connor stated they would like to see the ordinance passed at this board meeting, before the village has the referendum vote.

Mr. Fischer made a motion to adopt Ord. 67-3. Mr. Knott seconded.


