Approval of the Agenda:

Approval of Minutes

Commissioner Hof moved to approve the minutes of the August 14, 2023, meeting, with Commissioner Atilano seconding the motion. The motion carried on a voice vote.

Commissioner Erickson moved to approve the minutes of the October 9, 2023, meeting, with Commissioner Kopacz seconding the motion. The motion carried on a voice vote.

New Business:

Code Official Dettmer presented the information about the proposed signs for Lady Luck III, 1037 West Main Street, in lieu of a sign company representative. She explained the signs, both wall and monument, met the Village's codes.

She also presented for the signs for Sunshine Liquors, 1039-1041 West Main Street. These signs also meet Village code.

Commissioner Kevin Erickson moved to recommend to the Village Board approval of the signs for Lady Luck III and Sunshine Liquors, as requested for both wall signs and the monument signs. Commissioner Kopacz seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously by voice vote.

Old Business:

The commissioners continued to discuss possible standards maximum areas for impervious surfaces. Commissioner discussion included restricting "90-degree parking spaces", maintaining the required side yard setbacks, corner lots maintaining both front yard setbacks, and developing a maximum coverage for the front yard only. Commissioners requested a rough draft to consider for the next meeting.
