From the minutes of the first regular meeting of the Service Club, the following projects were planned: mow Sleepy Hollow Park, erect and improve street markers and signs, repair entranceways, repair dams and improve lakes for better fishing, and assist with the Fourth of July Fireworks Program. By the fall of that year, these projects were completed and others were underway or planned.
