The regular meeting of the Sleepy Hollow Corporate Authorities was called to order on June 15, 1981 at 7:45 PM by President Peterson. Roll was called and answered as follows: Grisolia, Matthews, Rabe, Roberts, Thomas, Zhe, Peterson present. Also present were Clerk Pofahl, Treasurer Scott, Attorney Kerry Pearson, Chief Bradley.

Mrs. Matthews moved to accept the minutes, second by Grisolia, carried by voice vote.

Treasurer's report: General--bills payable, \$3,754.49; receipts, \$1,445.11. Mr. Roberts moved to accept the report and pay the bills, second by Grisolia, roll call: Grisolia, Matthews, Rabe, Roberts, Thomas, Zhe aye. Water Dept. -- bills, \$1,695.04; receipts, \$3,659.49. Mrs. Matthews moved to accept the report and pay the bills, second by Roberts, roll call: Grisolia, Matthews, Rabe, Roberts, Thomas, Zhe aye. A correction was made in the total receipts on the Water Dept., correct total is \$3,659.49, Matthews moved to correct, second by Roberts, roll call: Grisolia, Matthews, Rabe, Roberts, Thomas, Zhe, aye.

Mrs. Zhe moved to reimburse Arnold and Rich for flowers, \$15, and to reinforce the concept of staying within a budget, Thomas second, roll call: Grisolia, Matthews, Rabe, Roberts, Thomas, Zhe, Peterson, aye.

The Police Committee will meet to look at the applications for part time Patrolmen.

Mr. Grisolia moved to approve raises for the Police Department, for full time officers, retroactive to May 1, 1981, second by Rabe, roll call:


