Village Board Minutes

August 31, 1981

The regular meeting of the Sleepy Hollow Corporate Authorities was called to order on August 31, 1981 at 7:40 PM by President Peterson. Roll was called and answered as follows: Grisolia, Matthews, Rabe, Roberts, Thomas, Peterson present; Zhe absent. Also present were Clerk Pofahl, Treasurer Pacchini, Chief Bradley, Attorney Pearson, Plan Commission Harlovic, ZBA Ward.

Mr. Grisolia moved to accept the minutes of the previous meeting, second by Roberts, carried by voice.

Treasurer's report -- General, acct. payable, \$11,747.16. Mr. Roberts moved to pay the bills, second by Rabe, roll call: Grisolia, Matthews, Rabe, Roberts, Thomas, aye. Water Dept., bills payable, \$4,145.33, Grisolia moved to pay the bills, Matthews second, roll call: Grisoliz, Matthews, Rabe, Roberts, Thomas aye. Ralph Schroeder should submit bills for services rendered as building inspector. The \$100,000 CD due 9-9-81 should be renewed for 30 days.

The next Board meeting will be Sept. 8, Tuesday due to Labor Day on Sept. 7.

Mrs. Pofahl report on her attendance at a Cash Management seminar at ECC, she will meet with Mrs. Pacchini, Mr. Thomas, and Mrs. Peterson.

Chief Bradley reported that several mini-bike riders are not obeying the rules and are destroying property. Mr. Grisolia moved to prohibit the riding of mini-bikes anywhere in the Village for a two week period, 9/1 - 9/14, second by Rabe, Mr. Roberts moved to table the motion until next Board meeting on September 8 to allow the Policemen to talk with the children and suggest they govern themselves, second by Rabe, carried by voice.

Mr. Thomas moved to pay<sup>ss</sup> Ordinance #21-26<sup>7</sup>-8 which is the levy for fiscal year 1981-82, second by Roberts, roll call: Grisoliz, Matthews, Rabe, Roberts, Thomas aye, Zhe absent.

Mr. Harlovic suggested that the Village resume talks with Gilberts regarding Jurisdictional Boundaries. Mrs. Matthews moved the Plan Commission work with Mary Kay Peck and DAIPC <sup>and/or on their own</sup> to work out an agreement with Gilberts, second by Grisolia, carried by voice. Mr. Harlovic will contact either Mary Kay or DAIPC President.

ZBA report - Mr. Ward presented the report of the August 25 meeting. Mrs. Thomas requested that the Board postpone a decision until the second meeting in November. Regarding the Township Road Department's request for a change in Zoning Use, the ZBA recommended granting the variance. Mr. Roberts moved to approve and accept the ZBA recommendation regarding the Township garage property, second by Thomas, carried by voice. The attorney will prepare an ordinance granting the variance to be presented in September.

Health - Mrs. Matthews had the water of Lake Sharon tested, she needs an interpretation of the report. Mrs. Matthews moved to pass Ordinance #13-2-2 regarding the cutting of weeds, second by Rabe, Mr. Thomas moved to table until further clarification can be made, second by Roberts, carried by voice.

Mr. Grisolia requested an executive session to discuss salaries for part time patrolman, concurrence by Thomas.

Mr. Rabe and Mrs. Matthews will investigate the feasibility of purchasing a backhoe for use by Road and Water Departments. Mr. Rabe is investigating gasoline prices.

Adjourn to Executive session, 10:00 PM.
