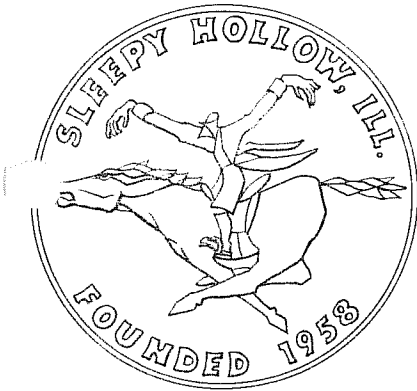

Village Board Minutes, January 4, 1982

The regular meeting of the Sleepy Hollow Corporate Authorities was called to order on January 4, 1982 by President Peterson at 7:35 PM. Roll was called and answered as follows: Grisolia, Matthews, Rabe, Roberts, Thomas arrived at 7:45, Zhe, Peterson. Also present were Clerk Pofahl, Treasurer Panning, Chief Bradley, Engineer Andersen.

Mrs. Matthews moved to accept the minutes of the previous meeting, second by Roberts, carried by voice vote.
Mr. Thomas arrived.

Treasurer's report: The Treasurer had several suggestions concerning time sheets for employees, and on handling of money received. All checks received will go to the Clerk who will keep a list then turn them over to the Treasurer; money received from sale of Village vehicle stickers and animal tags will be receipted in a separate book, a list of the money will be turned over to the Treasurer along with the cash and checks.

Bills Payable--General, Mr. Grisolia moved to pay the bills totaling \$8,068.87, second by Roberts, roll call: Grisolia, Matthews, Rabe, Roberts, Thomas, Zhe, aye.

MFT, Mrs. Matthews moved to pay MFT bills amounting to \$1,367.15, second by Rabe, roll call: Grisolia, Matthews, Rabe, Roberts, Thomas, Zhe, aye.

Water Dept., Mrs. Matthews moved to pay water dept. bills amounting to \$4,656.84, second by Roberts, roll call: Grisolia, Matthews, Rabe, Roberts, Thomas, Zhe, aye.

Mr. Grisolia moved to correct Gary Schwartz's salary as stated in the previous meeting, it was incorrectly stated at the time, it should be \$14,450 annually, approval of the percentage raise was given in the previous meeting, second by Matthews, roll call: Grisolia, Matthews, Rabe, Roberts, Thomas, Zhe, aye.

Residents of Glen Oak Drive, Maple Lane and Walnut Drive were present with questions and comments concerning snowplowing, salting and sanding of streets.
