Village Board Minutes, Feb. 20, 1984

Mr. Cook moved to pay Water Dept. DI&E bills of \$8600.00 including pre-approval of \$5100 to repair the backhoe with the understanding that this amount may exceed the appropriated amount, however, this work must be done to keep the system in good working condition, second by Matthews, all present aye.

Don Stevens has resigned from the Police Dept. he will be working full time for Hampshire. Mr. Treece moved to accept his resignation with regret, second by Rabe, carried by voice.

The engineer has prepared suggestions for 1984 road repair work.

Mr. Rabe moved to hire John Harmon to work in Public Works Dept. at \$5.00 per hour for 35-40 hours per week, no fringe benefits, second by Cook, all present aye.

Mr. Rabe moved to pass Ordinance #7-15-1 setting weight limits on the roads as of Feb. 21, second by Treece, all present aye.
