Ken Fishleigh, Algonquin Jaycees, requested permission to solicit members for a Sleepy Hollow chapter of Jaycees.


Mr. Hazzard has cut the septic line which drained into the swale, next Court date, January. Drain below Clai's driveway needs to be lowered.
