EXECUTIVE SESSION

Present were President Peterson; Trustees Dayon, Harney, Shields, and Roberts.

Dauids Litigation- Peterson needs to give a deposition before the end of this month. Court date will be in April. Someone from the Village should be there.

Treasurer- 5 people submitted applications. 1 woman from East Dundee without experience, and 1 man from Bartlett who appeared to be looking for full time work were not interviewed.

2 retired men and 1 woman resident were interviewed. One man was overqualified and hadn't had "hands on" experience for many years, the woman was underqualified with little accounting experience. William J. Heric had the best resume with "hands on"

Herich suggested \$10 (which was what "we" were thinking of) Shields felt a cap of 40 hours per month should be applied (\$400) He and Heric also talked of a clerk to work directly for the Treasurer at \$6 per hour with a cap of 40 hours per month (\$240) Shields was authorized to pursue this further with Heric and obtain recommendations for him
