First let me express our gratitude to the people of Sleepy Hollow for the use of the park grounds for the past several years. The men of Elgin Rugby Club have been fully aware over the years that we were guests in your community, and were responsible and accountable for any events related to the playing of Rugby matches and tournaments.


I believe our own members have kept this in mind and have done well. But we have had less fortune in controlling the behavior of some of our guest clubs. We regret any behaviour or circumstance which would offend any residents or which might have caused any damage to the grounds.

With that in mind, we do understand the concerns which were voiced at the meeting last Monday. We freely accept the conditions-of-use which were placed upon us:

1. We will use ground only across the road from the soccer fields.
2. We will park off-road - no exceptions!
3. We will continue to rent a portable toilet for home matches.
4. We will attempt to eliminate consumption of alcohol at the playing field.
5. We will be more diligent in our after-match clean-up.
6. We will arrange to play any tournaments elsewhere.

In closing: we appreciate the hospitality that has been extended to us by the people of Sleepy Hollow. We do not take it lightly, and do not wish to wear out our welcome further.
