EXECUTIVE SESSION

Meeting of the Regular Session adjourned into Executive Session at 11:05PM for the purpose of discussing land acquisition and possible litigation. Present were President Peterson; Trustees Harney, Johnson, Roberts, Shields, Tennis and Ward; Engineer Whiston; Deputy Clerk Olson; and Village Clerk McKeown.

1. Peterson spoke to Al Pagorsky concerning the sewer line. He needs to know by March 1. Suggested the possibility of 3-4% loan from the State.

Isn't the percent for Gilberts' and Sleepy Hollow's share larger than they should be? Is our share based on our FPA? If Elgin wins in the annexations can we recoup our money?

Cost figures given only ran to north side of I-90 on S.H. Road. From Sleepy Hollow Road to Randall is more money.

Trustees felt the sooner we put our words in writing the better. We could ask for more information. The Design is based on the assumption Elgin/Gilberts/Sleepy Hollow will be involved. We want Whiston to review percentage formula and obtain more information on the costs.

2. Gilberts is suing Elgin. Ron Roeser is the Attorney for Gilberts. Should we joint sue with Gilberts? Perhaps not as we may have problems in the future with Gilberts over communal boundaries. Should we sue alongside of Gilberts? We will leave it with Samuelson as to what course of legal action to take. On the otherhand the Trustees felt we must try for an injunction now. Several names of Attorneys knowledgeable with this problem were mentioned by Tennis. They were: Jack Seigle; John Mullens, Long Grove Attorney; Stu Diamon, IML Handbook; and Peterson, Heupt, Stucco, Sidley and Austin in Deerfield. How much money will this cost?

Harney moved with a second from Shields to adjourn the Meeting. Meeting was adjourned into Regular Session at 11:45PM.
