A special meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Sleepy Hollow was called to order by Floyd Falese, Village President.

Roll call was taken and answered as follows:

Mr. Fischer a proposal to the Board whereby a clothing allowance would be given to the policemen in the Village in lieu of a pay raise. This allowance is to help defray expenses which the men now pay themselves, such as uniforms, pistols, ammunition and miscellaneous equipment. Mr. Sabatino asked that this allowance be set at \$50.00 per year per man with at least one years service.


